This week's show examines...

Larry Pratt of GOA: Bump fire stocks and the NRA's folly of 'preemptive concession'

This Sunday (October 22), "Guns, Politics and Freedom" will examine attempts to pass federal gun control in the wake of the Las Vegas shootings. Valone's featured guest will be Larry Pratt, the Executive Director of Gun Owners of America. Second only to the NRA in terms of size, GOA is Washington's only true "no compromise" gun rights group.

In particular, the episode focuses on the NRA's folly in calling for regulation of so-called "bump stocks" by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (BATFE). The scheme to regulate rather than legislate has recently been echoed by Speaker Paul Ryan (R-WI).

Drawing on 23 years as a leader in the gun rights movement, F. Paul Valone is hosting a new show entitled "**Guns, Politics & Freedom**" on Sundays at 5:00 PM Eastern time as part of the "Sunday Night Political Power Block" on conservative talk station WFBT, 106.7 (Wilmington, NC), which streams live nationally at www.WilmingtonBigTalker.com
